

Remnant Christian Lifestyle at twilight O'Malley Family Bible study Aug 25, 2012

In outer space there are black holes that by intense gravitational forces suck planets, stars and galaxies into it. Even light has a difficult time breaking away. The gravity pull of the black hole would grow stronger the closer that you are pulled to it. Your momentum begins to double and triple. Given that you have access to an infinite amount of power you can escape the pull however there is a certain line of demarcation called the event horizon where no escape is possible. Past that point of no return means that your space ship can't escape no matter what infinite energy source you have. Not even light can escape past the event horizon.

The world, in my estimation, hasn't gotten to the event horizon of the bible. Looking around society is degrading at a quicker pace year over year trying to set a speed record to the finish line but there is still time left. It's impossible to pull the ship from being dragged into the darkness because Mi4:10 says that the world will be under a new style Babylonian control grid. What we still have time for is to get as many people woken up and onto the escape pods before the ship goes past the point of no return.



Mic 4:10 Twist and groan, people of Jerusalem, like a woman giving birth, for now you will have to leave the city and live in the open country. You will have to go to Babylon, but there the LORD will save you from your enemies.

The point of no return, I believe, is the marriage supper. In the parable of the wedding supper. The Master came and 5 wise virgins got into the wedding feast while 5 did not (Mt25:1-13). The 5 foolish virgins who wasn't prepared couldn't get into the wedding feast. Those outside the feast will face the conditions outlined in Mt22:11-14.

- Mat 25:1 Then shall the kingdom of heaven be likened unto ten virgins, who took their lamps, and went forth to meet the bridegroom.
- Mat 25:2 And five of them were foolish, and five were wise.
- Mat 25:3 For the foolish, when they took their lamps, took no oil with them:
- Mat 25:4 but the wise took oil in their vessels with their lamps.
- Mat 25:5 Now while the bridegroom tarried, they all slumbered and slept.
- Mat 25:6 But at midnight there is a cry, Behold, the bridegroom! Come ye forth to meet him.
- Mat 25:7 Then all those virgins arose, and trimmed their lamps.
- Mat 25:8 And the foolish said unto the wise, Give us of your oil; for our lamps are going out.

- Mat 25:9 But the wise answered, saying, Peradventure there will not be enough for us and you: go ye rather to them that sell, and buy for yourselves.
- Mat 25:10 And while they went away to buy, the bridegroom came; and they that were ready went in with him to the marriage feast: and the door was shut.
- Mat 25:11 Afterward came also the other virgins, saying, Lord, Lord, open to us.
- Mat 25:12 But he answered and said, Verily I say unto you, I know you not.
- Mat 25:13 Watch therefore, for ye know not the day nor the hour.
- Mat 22:11 But when the king came in to behold the guests, he saw there a man who had not on a wedding-garment:
- Mat 22:12 and he saith unto him, Friend, how camest thou in hither not having a wedding-garment? And he was speechless.
- Mat 22:13 Then the king said to the servants, Bind him hand and foot, and cast him out into the outer darkness; there shall be the weeping and the gnashing of teeth.
- Mat 22:14 For many are called, but few chosen.

This study isn't going to discuss the criteria in order to get into the wedding feast but what conditions may exist on earth right before the wedding feast that a Christian may have to adapt his life to in order increase his/her chances of surviving and be alive at the time of the wedding feast.

It should be the goal during this time to walk in all the commands of the bible in order to receive a wedding feast invitation Rev10:9

<u>Rev_19:9</u> And he saith unto me, Write, <u>Blessed are they that are bidden to the marriage supper</u> of the Lamb. And he saith unto me, These are true words of God.



There is a false doctrine of rapture before the wrath of God is poured down on the earth however in Rev6:9-11 you have God saying that you have Christians at the 5th seal on the earth being killed for standing on the word of God.

- Rev 6:9 And when he opened the fifth seal, I saw underneath the altar the souls of them that had been slain for the word of God, and for the testimony which they held:
- Rev 6:10 and they cried with a great voice, saying, How long, O Master, the holy and true, dost thou not judge and avenge our blood on them that dwell on the earth?
- Rev 6:11 And there was given them to each one a white robe; and it was said unto them, that they should rest yet for a little time, until their fellow-servants also and their brethren, who should be killed even as they were, should have fulfilled *their course*.

This shows that Christians will have to follow the advice in Mt10:16-18

RSV Matthew 10:16-18

- 16 "Behold, I send you out as sheep in the midst of wolves; so be wise as serpents and innocent as doves.
- 17 Beware of men; for they will deliver you up to councils, and flog you in their synagogues,

18 and you will be dragged before governors and kings for my sake, to bear testimony before them and the Gentiles.

What are we to expect? Persecution from all around.

The one with the most bite will be from the government. The phrase "We're from the government and we're here to help" will be far from the truth. The government will be the chief persecutor of Christians.



A secular government, you know the one that has a separation of church and state, is the most dangerous.

The Government is dangerous since:

- 1) they don't fear God,
- 2) they have no morality,
- 3) they are infiltrated by the wicked seed
- 4) the love of money and power drives their action.
- 5) Any perceived threat to their survival ,whether actual or not, they come down in force



Examples:

- Herod killing the males 2 years and under
- Pharaoh commanding all the male babies to be thrown into the Nile

When King David was on the run from King Saul an edomite who worked his way up to be the head of the herdsmen of Saul didn't have any issue of ratting out David and the Edomite didn't have any problem carrying out an order to kill all the priest 1Sam21:7-19

- 1Sa 21:7 Now a certain man of the servants of Saul was there that day, detained before Jehovah; and his name was Doeg the Edomite, the chiefest of the herdsmen that belonged to Saul.
- 1Sa 22:9 Then answered Doeg the Edomite, who stood by the servants of Saul, and said, I saw the son of Jesse coming to Nob, to Ahimelech the son of Ahitub.
- 1Sa 22:10 And he inquired of Jehovah for him, and gave him victuals, and gave him the sword of Goliath the Philistine.
- 1Sa 22:11 Then the king sent to call Ahimelech the priest, the son of Ahitub, and all his father's house, the priests that were in Nob: and they came all of them to the king.
- 1Sa 22:12 And Saul said, Hear now, thou son of Ahitub. And he answered, Here I am, my lord.
- 1Sa 22:13 And Saul said unto him, Why have ye conspired against me, thou and the son of Jesse, in that thou hast given him bread, and a sword, and hast inquired of God for him, that he should rise against me, to lie in wait, as at this day?
- 1Sa 22:14 Then Ahimelech answered the king, and said, And who among all thy servants is so faithful as David, who is the king's son-in-law, and is taken into thy council, and is honorable in thy house?
- 1Sa 22:15 Have I to-day begun to inquire of God for him? be it far from me: let not the king impute anything unto his servant, nor to all the house of my father; for thy servant knoweth nothing of all this, less or more.
- 1Sa 22:16 And the king said, Thou shalt surely die, Ahimelech, thou, and all thy father's house.

- 1Sa 22:17 And the king said unto the guard that stood about him, Turn, and slay the priests of Jehovah; because their hand also is with David, and because they knew that he fled, and did not disclose it to me. But the servants of the king would not put forth their hand to fall upon the priests of Jehovah.
- 1Sa 22:18 And the king said to Doeg, Turn thou, and fall upon the priests. And Doeg the Edomite turned, and he fell upon the priests, and he slew on that day fourscore and five persons that did wear a linen ephod.
- 1Sa 22:19 And Nob, the city of the priests, smote he with the edge of the sword, both men and women, children and sucklings, and oxen and asses and sheep, with the edge of the sword.

The government doesn't always have to rely on Edomites or other wicked seedline but many times your own people are willing to rat you out to the government for favors making them two fold sons of hell Mat23:15

Mat 23:15 Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye compass sea and land to make one proselyte; and when he is become so, ye make him twofold more a son of hell than yourselves.

Such were the Ziphites (1Chron4:16), of the tribe of Juda. David's own kinsmen ratted him out to King Saul and offered to help hunt him down 1Sam23:19-24. Some brotherly love.

- 1Ch 4:16 And the sons of Jehallelel: Ziph, and Ziphah, Tiria, and Asarel.
- 1Sa 23:19 Then came up the Ziphites to Saul to Gibeah, saying, Doth not David hide himself with us in the strongholds in the wood, in the hill of Hachilah, which is on the south of the desert?
- 1Sa 23:20 Now therefore, O king, come down, according to all the desire of thy soul to come down; and our part shall be to deliver him up into the king's hand.
- 1Sa 23:21 And Saul said, Blessed be ye of Jehovah; for ye have had compassion on me.
- 1Sa 23:22 Go, I pray you, make yet more sure, and know and see his place where his haunt is, *and* who hath seen him there; for it is told me that he dealeth very subtly.
- 1Sa 23:23 See therefore, and take knowledge of all the lurking-places where he hideth himself, and come ye again to me of a certainty, and I will go with you: and it shall come to pass, if he be in the land, that I will search him out among all the thousands of Judah.
- 1Sa 23:24 And they arose, and went to Ziph before Saul: but David and his men were in the wilderness of Maon, in the Arabah on the south of the desert.

This time frame you have the government exercising near full political and religious control, similar to China. You can go to church in China however the Churches are controlled by the state. Same here in the US. Not to the extent in China but one day it'll be.

The government has many control systems in place to prevent the Churches from going against the state. FEMA has partnered with thousands of Churches in the "Clergy Response Team"



program where the government wishes are carried out by the Churches ie: Direct parishioners to go to assembly/containment/concentration areas or encourage parishioners to turn in their weapons (violating Jesus' command of owning a sword/gun Lk22:36)



<u>Luke 22:36</u> And he said unto them, But now, he that hath a purse, let him take it, and likewise a wallet; and he that hath none, let him sell his cloak, and buy a sword.

The government further inroads to controlling the church is by having the Church incorporate itself (become a corporation). Under corporate law the Attorney General of that State is the ultimate head of that Corporation/Church thus removing Jesus as the head of the Church and putting man in place of God. The government can regulate or close the corporation church.

Further control on a national level is having the Churches become 501c3 organizations. This stifles their voice since they can't urge their parishioners to vote for any Pro-Life... candidate or urge to vote out of office any anti-Christian leaning politician without fearing the IRS taking away their tax-exempt status and fining them.

Under the Internal Revenue Code, all section 501(c)(3) organizations are absolutely prohibited from directly or indirectly participating in, or intervening in, any political campaign on behalf of (or in opposition to) any candidate for elective public office. Contributions to political campaign funds or public statements of position (verbal or written) made on behalf of the organization in favor of or in opposition to any candidate for public office clearly violate the prohibition against political campaign activity. Violating this prohibition may result in denial or revocation of tax-exempt status and the imposition of certain excise taxes.

Taking away tax-exempt status will torq off many parishioners since they put that down their total offerings on their 1040 tax form on April 15. Putting their offerings down on the 1040 form is stealing that offering you made to Jesus so you not only didn't pay your tithe but you stole from God (Mal3:8). By being tax exempt the Churches are enabling their members to sin against God. If you make a tithe or offering, it's gone from your hands never to see your palms so don't put it on your 1040 form.

Mal 3:8 Will a man rob God? yet ye rob me. But ye say, Wherein have we robbed thee? In tithes and offerings.



The churches are also controlled by the organizational structure of the church itself. If the pastor gets out of line from the hierarchy then not only will he be out of a job but out of his church provided housing and church provided retirement plan since too few preachers own their own church building.

The churches are also controlled by the members since most members haven't read their bible nor care to and they want the preacher to tickle their ears with non-confrontational messages 2Tim4:3



<u>2Ti 4:3</u> For the time will come when they will not endure the sound doctrine; but, having itching ears, will heap to themselves teachers after their own lusts;

2Pt3:11 asks what manner ought you to be? That is the question of this study. We see a persecution is on the horizon since Ecc1:9 says we are on a hamster wheel and what was done in the past will be done in the present and future.

<u>2Pe_3:11</u> Seeing that these things are thus all to be dissolved, what manner of persons ought ye to be in *all* holy living and godliness,

Ecc 1:9 That which hath been is that which shall be; and that which hath been done is that which shall be done: and there is no new thing under the sun.

As a remnant Christian soldier you ought to be ready to bug out when the time comes if that is your decision. All throughout the New Testament you have the Jews (both leaders and non-leaders) and political leaders stirring up trouble and persecuting Christians.

Act 12:1 Now about that time Herod the king put forth his hands to afflict certain of the church.

Act 12:2 And he killed James the brother of John with the sword.

Act 12:3 And when he saw that it pleased the Jews, he proceeded to seize Peter also. And *those* were the days of unleavened bread.

Act 8:1 And Saul was consenting unto his death. And there arose on that day a great persecution against the church which was in Jerusalem; and they were all scattered abroad throughout the regions of Judaea and Samaria, except the apostles.

Act 13:50 But the Jews urged on the devout women of honorable estate, and the chief men of the city, and stirred up a persecution against Paul and Barnabas, and cast them out of their borders.

There are examples upon examples of the Jews in the book of Acts and in Paul's letters of Jews and Political leaders coming against Christians and they haven't changed in 2,000 years.

First Christians must accept that persecution will come into their lives from the Political, Religious or Social fronts as 2Tim3:12 and Heb12:6-8 point out. If you or your church has not had persecution come into your life then you might want to investigate why since according to the bible you will be persecuted. That should tell you that you are in the wrong church or have a lifestyle that is opposed to biblical Christianity.



2Ti_3:12 Yea, and all that would live godly in Christ Jesus shall suffer persecution.

Heb 12:6 For whom the Lord loveth he chasteneth, And scourgeth every son whom he receiveth.

Heb 12:7 It is for chastening that ye endure; God dealeth with you as with sons; for what son is there whom *his* father chasteneth not?

Heb 12:8 But if ye are without chastening, whereof all have been made partakers, then are ye bastards, and not sons.

Secondly you have the stamina to go thru and endure all that God sends your way 1Cor10:13



1Cor_10:13 There hath no temptation taken you but such as man can bear: but God is faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation make also the way of escape, that ye may be able to endure it.

Thirdly you may have to endure the persecution until the state puts you to death.

Rev 2:10 Fear not the things which thou art about to suffer: behold, the devil is about to cast some of you into prison, that ye may be tried; and ye shall have tribulation ten days. Be thou faithful unto death, and I will give thee the crown of life.

This is why being mobile and on the run may keep the hands of the state off you and your family. Looking at the example of Jesus. Jesus was on the run from the Jewish leaders for three and a half years because He didn't have a fixed location. Lk9:58, Jn3:8

<u>Luk 9:58</u> And Jesus said unto him, The foxes have holes, and the birds of the heaven *have* nests; but the Son of man hath not where to lay his head.

<u>Joh_3:8</u> The wind bloweth where it will, and thou hearest the voice thereof, but knowest not whence it cometh, and whither it goeth: so is every one that is born of the Spirit.

Being on the lamb requires total faith that Jesus will provide your needs. Jesus taught that you will be provided for Mt6:31-34

Mat 6:31 Be not therefore anxious, saying, What shall we eat? or, What shall we drink? or, Wherewithal shall we be clothed?

Mat 6:32 For after all these things do the Gentiles seek; for your heavenly Father knoweth that ye have need of all these things.

Mat 6:33 But seek ye first his kingdom, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.

Mat 6:34 Be not therefore anxious for the morrow: for the morrow will be anxious for itself. Sufficient unto the day is the evil thereof.

Christians provided each other substances Act4:32 The Christians sold off their property which was a good thing since persecution forced them away from their land.

Act 4:32 The group of believers was one in mind and heart. None of them said that any of their belongings were their own, but they all shared with one another everything they had.

Act 4:33 With great power the apostles gave witness to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus, and God poured rich blessings on them all.

Act 4:34 There was no one in the group who was in need. Those who owned fields or houses would sell them, bring the money received from the sale,

Act 4:35 and turn it over to the apostles; and the money was distributed according to the needs of the people.



It was during the persecution that God's word was spread out everywhere. Christians will be gathering in home churches since the established churches will be under government control. Jesus and the Apostles taught in homes since most in the "churches/temples" of that day rejected the message that they were giving.

Being that small home churches will be the light of the world everyone should be taking the opportunity to study so that they can lead themselves, their family and others in bible study and worship. 2Tim2:15, Acts17:11

<u>2Ti_2:15</u> Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.

Act 17:11 Now these were more noble than those in Thessalonica, in that they received the word with all readiness of the mind, examining the Scriptures daily, whether these things were so.

The most important take away is to pray for peace and that you will be counted worthy not to have to go thru the event horizon that the world will be spiraling down into. Lk21:36, Lk18:1, Jer29:11-13

<u>Luk_21:36</u> Watch ye therefore, and pray always, that ye may be accounted worthy to escape all these things that shall come to pass, and to stand before the Son of man.

<u>Luk 18:1</u> And he spake a parable unto them to this end, that men ought always to pray, and not to faint;

Jer 29:11 For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, saith the LORD, thoughts of peace, and not of evil, to give you an expected end.

Jer 29:12 Then shall ye call upon me, and ye shall go and pray unto me, and I will hearken unto you.

Jer 29:13 And ye shall seek me, and find me, when ye shall search for me with all your heart.

Jesus, I pray that we, your Christians are worthy to escape all that you are sending our way. Grant us peace and comfort in the days ahead.
