Fantastic Hookers of the Bible

Being in a Toastmaster club for the past 6 years, I've learned that you need to use something to catch someone's attention, to draw them in, to focus their attention on you. That is a Hooker. A hook may or may not hold if the line that you are feeding them is weak.

You must cast a message in such a way that you attract with their interests. If they don't swallow your hook then you will lose your audience. The bible is a rich feeding ground in topics that you could easily troll and find a bait that someone would be tempted to bite. Some of the topics that one could start off a conversation and then turn the conversation into how one needs to be saved are:

- Science

What does the bible speak on in science? Pick a topic below and speak on how the bible spoke of it first and now it's confirmed by science. If the Bible is accurate from a science point of view then it must be right from a salvation point of view.

- History

The bible is a history book. Genesis to Nehemiah and Matthew to Acts are historical books (all the books are historical but these 21 books are more written in a history like way). One can look up names, dates, places, events and find out that those people were alive and did those acts at that place.

- Emotional

Loss, suffering, Love, endurance all are in the Bible. Who can deny the love of the Father to us that He sent Jesus to die instead for us. You can speak of the suffering that Jesus went thru, the spitting the hitting, the lashes on his back that ripped chunks of his flesh off, blood oozing, squirting from his body (Is 53:5) how he had to endure the rejection of the people that he was dying for. The 6 hours of hanging on the cross in intense agony for committing no crime. That is a truly emotional connection viewpoint.

- Astronomy

The bible was written long time ago so it wouldn't have any astronomy type of items in the bible right? If a previous study (2 Calendars of the Bible: 2 confusing or 2 simple) I showed how you could prove the year Jesus was born (year 0) based on Astronomy and the events in the bible Some of the stars mentioned in the Old Testament:

- *Kimah*, the Pleiades;
- the *Kesil*, Orion;
- *Ash*, or *Ayish*, the Hyades;
- *Mezarim*, the Bears (Great and Little);
- *Mazzaroth*, Venus (Lucifer and Hesperus);
- *Hadre theman* — "the chambers of the south" — Canopus, the Southern Cross, and a Centauri;
- *Nachash*, Draco.

- Farming

How do you raise a garden and raise livestock. The bible has many verses that speak on proper animal ratio of male and female (Gen 32:14-15), Orchard management (Lev 19:23-25), Keeping the genetics strong (Lev 19:19), How to plant seeds (Dt 22:9) and how to treat poor performance of trees (Lk 13:8-9) If Jesus cares about plants & animals then He cares much more on tending to one of his sheep (Mt 6:26-32) and how to become one of Jesus' sheep in his sheep pen.

- Legal

If someone is of the legal persuasion then speaking about the law written down by Moses from God and how it's pertinent now days could be the opening conversation. Knowing Exodus 20-23, Leviticus 11-27, Deuteronomy 4-8 and how the non-sacrificial sections of the law is applicable now days would be a great topic A good starter is on theft. The bible says that if you are caught stealing you have to repay 5 times the damage (Ex 22:1). If you refuse then you could sold into slavery until the debt is paid off (Ex 22:1). Murders, rapist, kidnappers are all quickly put to death (Num 35:16-17), not 30, 40, 50 years down the road.

- Prophecy

If they are into prophecy then the bible is the book for them. Most want to know about the end times which there are numerous books (ie Revelation) and chapters (ie Matthew 24) and passages that can connect with the world today. That could be your springboard for a talk about how to save yourself from the wrath to come by doing what Jesus told you to do to be saved.

- Far out of the box

For those on the fringe, that likes sci-fi then the bible has a in for that angle as well. In Genesis (Gen 6:2-4) it speaks of the sons of God married the daughters of man and produced giants. Referring to the book of Enoch, it has a more detail explanation of that Genesis passage. An alien invasion (fallen angels) from another dimension (the spiritual realm) came down to earth and mated with women. Their offspring created giants that became cannibals. God was furious and imprisoned the fallen angels and wiped out the giant race. Since the giants were part man and part angel the flesh part died but the spirit part was alive and these became the demons that torment men to this day (Enoch 15:7-12).

- Conspiracy

The setup of Jesus could be another discussion. Jesus lived a sinless life (1 Pt 2:22) yet there were forces that were determined to kill him (Jn 8:40). These forces falsely arrested Him (Mt 26:47-50), set up false witnesses to testify against Him (Mt 26:59), broke all the court laws in order to convict Him. Once they convicted Him they took Him to a higher court (Romans) and put the political squeeze on Pilate to release Barabbas and sentence Jesus to death (Lk 23:16-25). After Jesus' death these same forces killed many of the Apostles and persecuted Jesus followers (Acts 9:1-4).

These forces are still in play as you can see there are forces out there suing and protesting and are not stopping in trying to remove Jesus' name or the cross or any other related symbols from all Government, schools, TV, radio, commencement... activities.

- Archeology

Sodom and Gomorrah and the city of Jericho didn't exist many people claimed however archeologist flipping shovels found those cities. Many towns that were once thought of only in the bible have now been found. Comparing the accuracy of the bible using archeology could be used as showing the validity of the rest of the bible which means do what Jesus says to do and don't do what Jesus says not to do.

Example: The Assyrian tablets describe the 10 Northern tribes exile in Assyria when they were taken out of the land of Israel.

- Military

The US is in a midst of multiple wars: Afghanistan, Iraq, Libya. We are stirring the pot in Iran and had a helping hand in Egypt so those pumping their fists for war should read from the time the Israelites leaving Egypt to the conquering of the nation of Israel (10 northern tribes) by the Assyrians and the conquering on the nation of Judah (2 southern tribes) by the Babylonians. There were massive armies numbering in the hundreds of thousands (185,000 came against Jerusalem alone). You can tie it in with Jesus will protect you against the hordes invading if you are covered under his wings. In the 185,000 army example, the angel of the Lord came down and killed all of them in one night.

- Health

The bible describes how to be healthy so a person interested in good health & nutrition would be interested in this topic. Things like what foods to eat and not to eat (Lev 11:1-47) and how those foods still are not good to eat. Take a pig for instance. Pig's meat may contain worms which if eaten could produce triconosis or other diseases that could be fatal. A pig is a pig, hasn't changed since Jesus was resurrected.

- **Economics**

How does one become wealthy? Most people want to hear that subject and the bible speaks about this. Tithing (Mal 3:8-10) Lending (Prov 19:17) not taking loans (Prov 22:7), Don't counter sign a note for anyone (Prov 22:26), counting the cost before starting a project (Lk 14:28) and others. If the bible speaks on how to save money then you can tie that to a talk that the bible speaks on how to save your soul from the lake of fire.

- **Child rearing**

How should you raise your child? Many parents vacillate from being strict (punishment) to being understanding (Dr Spock). The bible speaks in Proverbs how to raise a child so that he/she would be a blessing to the mother and father (what parent wouldn't want that!). The bible speaks on how to correct (Prov 23:13-14, Prov 13:24) how to do it (Eph 6:4, Col 3:20-21) when to train (Dt 6:7)

There are many other topics (Music, Afflictions, Government, Paleontology, sexuality, love, hate, marriage, divorce, witchcraft...) which if one puts their mind to it could think up a way to begin a conversation and then lead them to discussions on salvation and what one needs to do (Acts 2:38)

In a war you use overwhelming force against an opponent. This opponent is the satanic spirit holding the person in bondage (Mt 12:30). The only way to fight an adversary is to use a power greater than what the adversary has.

This is two weapons: prayer power and prayer amplification.

First is prayer power: praying that Jesus goes before you and guides you to the persons that he wants to save and that he goes and:

- takes their blinders off their eyes (Is 42:7)
- unstops their ears (Ps 40:6)
- changes their hearts (Ps 51:10)
- renews their spirits (Ps 51:10)
- grants the ability to repent (2 Tim 2:25, Acts 5:31)
- plants hedge of protection (Job 1:10)
- sends helping angels (Ps 34:7)
- bind the forces of Hell and loosen the armies of Jesus (Mt 18:18)

Next is prayer amplification. You may not (Ecc 4:12) or may (James 4:7) be able to withstand the devil by yourself - depends on your endurance and fighting power but once you team up with multiple Christians your ability to repel and go on the offence is phenomenal (Dt 32:30).

All comes down to you picking up the bible and reading it so that when the time is right that you will be able to preach and teach the gospel so as to lead them to salvation.

Once you get a bite on the hook ie the bobber goes down in the water such as a head nod, facial expression (eye brow raise, shine in the eyes...), accepting body language, voice confirmation then it's time to test the tension.

If the bite was a strong one (strong feedback) then pull hard on the string and reel in the person.

A strong response may not mean the hook is properly set and the pull in of the line may loosen or yank out the hook. If the hook loosens then let out some slack, be patient and try pulling in a bit slower.

If the bite was soft then let out a little slack, be patient, feed them a little more and wait until the line is taut then reel them in.

Don't be discouraged if you are not 100% successful. Jesus wasn't 100% successful since Judas left and betrayed Him.

Thomas Edison attempted over 6,000 times before he perfected the filament for the light bulb.

If the fish doesn't take the hook or the hook comes free of the fish then you may try casting the line back at the specific fish, target a group of fish, or cast the hook to an area where you know fish are likely to visit.

Just as in fishing, one hook and bait isn't universal for all fishes. Many times you have to try different lures before you find the right one for a specific fish.

It would be a blessing that each hook that you cast will land a fish but that is not a reality. Consider using a trout line. Plant ideas into the minds of people. Those ideas will begin to grow and another will pull the fish in (Jn 4:37-38)

Some fishes are impossible to get a hook in. In this case just pack up your tackle box and move to a different spot where fish are biting (Mk 6:11)

Some possible ways to soften the stiff necks is to get the Word of God into their minds by any means possible. Some include:

- letting them borrow a word for word bible movies such as: The gospel of John, Matthew, Acts of the Apostles.
- letting them borrow Christian themed movies (containing repentance, believing [I haven't seen one with baptism but 2 of 3 is better than none]) such as: Time Changer, Fireproof, Facing the Giants, Flywheel, Faith like Potatoes, Book of Ruth...
- giving CDs with the bible on it (audio or mp3 versions)
- booklets covering various topics that are brought up
- music CD containing songs dealing with belief, repentance, baptism, salvation, Jesus
- drop off pamphlets/business cards with bible truths
- bibles if they don't have one (electronic or paper)
- create your own bible studies to teach yourself, your family and send to others
- tie in a ordinary conversation biblical events that tie into what is being spoken about.

The main thrust is to put on your hip waders and get into the water and start casting hooks out. If you don't even bother to cast out a hook, what will your fate be when you are standing in front of Jesus at judgment day? (Mt 7:22-23),

We should be always at work spreading the gospel (Jn 5:17) lest you be found asleep (Lk 12:37)
