
What did Jesus say about Salvation? – Aug 25, 2019

The jailer guarding Paul and Silas at the Thyatira prison asked them after the earthquake that opened the doors and unshackled the prisoners, "Sirs, what must I do to be saved?" (Acts 16:30). The crowds in Jerusalem at Pentecost asked Peter "Brethren, what shall we do?" There are many verses of the Apostles responding to or explaining salvation; but what did Jesus himself say about salvation if His words only in the 4 gospels are considered?

Jesus spoke on salvation in 3 areas: "saved", "eternal life" & "kingdom". The 3 exercises below reveals what Jesus said and expects of us for our salvation. Go to the verses listed using a New American Standard Bible (NASB) and find the missing words. Add the words into the cross-word boxes to find the actions Jesus said one must do.





Jesus said that "to be saved" you must enter thru him and that belief, faith, repentance, forgiving others, being baptized and having endurance to last to the end is required.




