June 27, 2010 - Texas, Louisiana, Mississippi and Alabama Prayer Proclamations to bring down Curses from Jesus Christ



Sunday June 27, 2010 Texas, Louisiana, Mississippi and Alabama participated in a Day of Prayer. Below is each state's proclamation enabling section.

TEXAS

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK PERRY, Governor of Texas, under the authority vested in me by the Constitution and Statutes of the State of Texas do hereby proclaim Sunday, June 27, 2010, **as a Day of Prayer** in the State of Texas. I urge Texans of **all faiths and religious traditions to offer prayers** on that day for the healing of individuals, the rebuilding of communities and the restoration of entire Gulf Coast environment in the wake of this disaster.

LOUISIANA

I, Bobby Jindal, Governor of the State of Louisiana, do hereby proclaim June 27, 2010 as a Statewide **Day of Prayer** In the State of Louisiana and in the Gulf of Mexico.

MISSISSIPPI

NOW, THEREFORE, I Haley Barbour, Governor of the State of Mississippi, hereby proclaim June 27, 2010, as a **Day of Prayer** in Mississippi for relief from this crisis and restoration of the Gulf of Mexico and the shoreline

ALABAMA

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Bob Riley, Governor of Alabama, do hereby declare Sunday, June 27, 2010, as a Day of Prayer in Alabama and encourage individuals to pray on their own or with others, **according to their own faith,** in an expression of faith and hope.

Those four proclamations are an offense to Jesus and they have caused Jesus to pour out even more calamities upon the United States. Why?

Five reasons why Jesus will find those proclamations offensive:

- 1) Who are you praying to?
- 2) Who are you praying for?
- 3) How long are you going to be praying for?
- 4) How are you presenting yourselves?
- 5) What are you praying for?

Who are you praying to?

Is it Jesus, Buddha, Allah, some Hindu false god? It's nonspecific. Texas has the proclamation statement of "all faiths and religious traditions" and Alabama has "according to their own faith" – a crock pot full of deities. Mississippi and Louisiana has it sanitized and just mentions a Day of Prayer. Florida, which has more to lose, didn't bother to issue a Prayer Proclamation. The four Governors have gone the political route to please men rather than Jesus ([1] Galatians 1:10) by lowering Jesus to the level of all the false gods in doing so they have raised the importance of all the false gods to the Creator's [Jesus] level.

This Luke warmness of pleasing man and God is offensive to Jesus. Jesus states he will vomit you out of his mouth for being lukewarm ([2] Revelations 3:16) and he especially hates double-minded men ([3] Psalms 119:113). It seems to me that the Governors are ashamed, frightened or are opposed to name Jesus as to the one to pray to. They will find out that if they are ashamed for Jesus then Jesus will be ashamed of them on Judgment day ([4] Mark 8:38, [5]

Psalms 50:22). The politicians, it appears to me, are more concerned with satisfying all the religions thus keeping the campaign donation rolling in. Can you imagine if a politician stated there's no God but Jesus? The Apostles told the Religious rulers that it is better to do the will of God rather than man (**[6] Acts 4:19-20**) The bible states concerning Jesus that:

- a) no other name [Jesus Christ of Nazareth] under heaven is for salvation ([7] Acts 4:10,12)
- b) that every knee shall bow before Jesus ([8] Romans 14:11)
- c) there is only 1 mediator [Jesus] between God and man ([9] 1 Timothy 2:5)
- d) everything was made by Jesus and nothing exist that wasn't created by Jesus ([10] 1 Corinthians 8:6)
- e) ALL judgment is placed under Jesus so everyone should honor the Son as they should the Father ([11] John 5:22-23)
- f) the other gods are false and cannot eat, speak or do anything ([12] Jeremiah 10:5, [13] 1 Corinthians 8:4)

All the Governors refused to state the obvious that if you are praying to a God then maybe that God has certain requirements that those praying to him have to keep. If those people choose not to keep his requirements, then maybe that God punishes those who disobey his commandments. Ergo... this crisis is a result of our continual disobedience.

Texas, Mississippi and Alabama released their day of prayer on 6/23/10 [for the 6/27/10 day of prayer]. On the same day, 6/23/10, the Remote Operated Vehicle bumped into the vent pipe causing BP to remove the cap. The amount of oil entering the water dramatically increased from a high estimate of 100,000 barrels of oil a day (before the cap was removed) to potentially 4,000,000 barrels per day (after the cap was removed). Jesus didn't seem impressed with the prayer proclamations. The increased curses is in line with ([14] Deuteronomy 28:15-68) which states that if you don't follow Jesus commandments and continue to sin then he'll curse you again and again until you: 1) finally do what he wants you to do or 2) go broke, lose all you possess and die miserable (basic theme of a good country and western song)

Who are you praying for?

What people are you praying for? The Children of destruction ([15] 1 John 3:10) or Jesus' people (1 John 3:10). Should we pray for those that Jesus hate? ([16] 2 Chronicles 19:2, [17] Psalms 97:10) Jesus will curse his people for blessing the cursed people ([18] 2 Samuel 19:6-7, [16] 2 Chronicles 19:2). Ignorance is no excuse ([20] Genesis 20:4-6). That is why you need to be very careful in praying for or blessing anyone that is not a true Christian.

How long are you going to be praying for?

A single day? Are you serious? This will do even more damage since the oil will keep gushing up after the single day of prayer. I'm glad we were able to fit a single day to pray to God to pinch off the oil. Most people will see that the oil is coming out the same as without the day of prayer and will come to the conclusion that prayer doesn't work and ultimately that God doesn't exist or respond to your pleas.

Abraham is a perfect example of immediate and delay answer of prayers. In [21] Genesis 24:15, Abraham sends out his servant to find a wife for Isaac (Abraham's son.) The servant arrives in the city of Nahor and prays to God to show him the woman that would be the wife of Isaac. Before the servant has ended his prayers, Rebecca came out to get some more water. An instant answer to a prayer.

Abraham is also an example of waiting years for a answer for his prayers since in [22] Genesis 12:2,4 Abraham was 75 years old when he began praying for a son but it took him until he was 100 ([23] Genesis 21:5) to have one -25 years of praying before receiving an answer!!!.

How are you presenting yourselves?

Prayers only work if Jesus hasn't:

- a) Closed his eyes to your plight ([24] Deuteronomy 31:17-18, [25] Ezekiel 7:22)
- b) Closed his ears to your cries ([26] Job 35:13, [27] John 9:31)
- c) Closed his nose to your sacrifice ([28] Jeremiah 6:20, [29] Amos 5:22)
- d) Isn't laughing at your situation ([30] Psalms 2:4, [31] Proverbs 1:26)

Jesus knows the hearts of me ([32] John 2:25) and where there is true repentance or the appearance of repentance. Such as the following sin cycle:

- 1) Calamity hit (ie 9/11)
- 2) People rush into church and pray
- 3) Life returns to normal
- 4) People rush out of church
- 5) People engage in same sins before calamity
- 6) Calamity hits (return to step 2)

True repentance causes people to turn their life around after a calamity hits them and they don't go back to sinning like a dog returning to their vomit ([33] Proverbs 26:11) once they have repented.

Jesus is a Jealousy God ([34] Exodus 34:14 [35] Exodus 20:5) and numerous examples thru out the bible clearly point that he doesn't stand for people blessing and praying to false gods and he will pour his wrath on them. To expect an answer from Jesus when you are praying with a Rabbi, Muslim, Hindu to a generic god for people who haven't repented for only a single day - then you are wasting your time and God's time and he'll notch up the devastation to make you realize it. Some people will repent and turn to Jesus but others will curse God due to their calamity ([36] Revelation 16:9)

What are you praying for?

In treating someone that is injured, there is a set procedure in caring for that person:

- 1) Stop the Bleeding
- 2) Start the Breathing
- 3) Protect the wound
- 4) Treat for Shock

In reviewing the proclamations, all of them are trying to treat for shock. None of them are trying to stop the bleeding. The patient will die if you treat for shock before you stop the bleeding. The individuals, communities and environment won't recover until you get the well from stop bleeding oil like a punctured arterial vein.

All the prayer proclamations are limp wristed call to actions since the proclamations are asking for:

<u>Texas</u>: healing of individuals, rebuilding communities, restoration of environment <u>Louisiana</u>: hope for an end, recovery of coastline, fish, wildlife and costal area <u>Mississippi</u>: relief from this crisis, restoration of Gulf of Mexico and the shoreline Alabama: expression of faith and hope

None of the proclamations are calling on Jesus to send an earthquake to stop the spill. An earthquake? Impossible!!! With God all things are possible ([61] Mt 19:26) or don't you have enough faith and belief to move mountains ([62] Mt 17:20)

Another question is: Who caused the spill?

Did Jesus lift his hedge of protection from the US and allow Satan to attack us? Similarly like Jesus lifting the hedge of protection from around Job and Satan inflecting Job with all types of problems ([37] Job 1:10,12)

Did Jesus pour a little from his judgment bowl upon the earth ([38] Revelations 16:3) as a preview of the bowl at judgment time?

It's uncertain which sinarios we are in, however the effects are the same. There is only one solution to get out of this mess but we as a nation or world haven't gotten to that point yet

([39] 2 Chronicles 7:14, [40] Matthew 13:15, [41] 1 Kings 8:47-50, [42] 2 Chronicles 6:36-39)

What should a proper Prayer Proclamation have called for?

Jesus is the Judge of this world and Christians have the right to enter into his court and submit motions and pleadings. It's very important to know what the Bible describes pertaining on how to become a Christian otherwise you may be locked out or throw out of the Court room ([19] Matthew 7:22-23). Jesus as a Judge can't act if Christians don't enter the court and present their requests to Jesus ([43] John 5:30). This is what Christians need to know but aren't being taught that Jesus knows what you need ([44] Matthew 6:8) but is waiting on you to request it ([45] Matthew 7:7). If you don't ask for something then you won't get anything. If you don't knock on the door then the door won't be opened for you.

I believe a proper Prayer Proclamation would have addressed four areas:

- 1) Ask Jesus to grant the people the ability to repent ([46] Acts 11:18, [47] Psalms 7:12-13)
- 2) Call on all the people to repent of their Sins against Jesus

([48] Psalms 51:17, [49] Matthew 3:8, [50] Ezekiel 14:6, [51] Ezekiel 18:31-32)

- 3) Call on Jesus to create a powerful earthquake at the pipe to pinch off the oil
 - ([52] Psalms 20:4, [53] Acts 16:26, [54] Matthew 28:2, [55] John 14:13-14, [56] Psalms 116:1-2)
- 4) Call on Jesus to clean up the damaged area

([57] 2 Chronicles 7:14, [58] Psalms 50:15, [59] Romans 8:26-28, [60] Deuteronomy 23:5)

There is a lack of the Fear of Jesus Christ in this society..... but what does the *Fear of the Lord* mean? How do you *Fear the Lord*?



Governor Jindal Orders June 27th as Statewide Day of Prayer for Perseverance Through Oil Spill Crisis

BATON ROUGE - Today, Governor Bobby Jindal issued a proclamation declaring June 27th as a "Statewide Day of Prayer" for perseverance through the oil spill crises.

Proclamation on Statewide Day of Prayer:

WHERAS, Louisiana is entering the 66th day of an economic and environmental crisis caused by the BP oil spill in the Gulf of Mexico, which is the largest oil spill in American history; and,

WHEREAS, The Deepwater Horizon oil spill already has a profound effect on Louisiana, its coastline and its people and our entire Louisiana way of life; and,

WHEREAS, The people of coastal Louisiana are being directly impacted by the closure of our waters for fishing and oyster harvesting and many are struggling to make ends meet or provide for their families; and,

WHEREAS, The continuing BP oil spill disaster follows the damage caused by Hurricanes Katrina, Rita, Gustav and Ike, which impacted many of the same communities now being struck by oil: and.

WHERAS, Louisiana, known around the world as the Sportsman's Paradise, is blessed with a bounty of natural treasures, including unique wildlife and fisheries and vibrant communities and traditions that are now threatened due to the ongoing catastrophic damage to our wetlands; and,

WHEREAS, The suffering of Louisiana's state bird, the brown pelican, which was only recently removed from the endangered species list, has become symbolic of the continuing damage caused by the BP oil spill to our fragile coastline and the entire ecosystem it supports; and,

WHEREAS, Louisiana's people are coming together to help each other now during this time of crisis just as they have persevered through losses before; and Louisiana fishermen, shrimpers and oyster harvesters are now on the frontlines of the oil spill, fighting to protect our coast; and,

WHEREAS, Hundreds of members of the Louisiana National Guard are working tirelessly to shield our fragile marshland from oil that continues to hit our shores — even as many of them just recently returned from fighting for our country overseas; and Louisiana scientists, biologists, veterinarians and wildlife agents battle against the oil every day to rescue and rehabilitate wildlife that survive being impacted by the oil; and,

WHEREAS, Coastal parish leaders from all along the coast have come together to implement their own ideas to protect our waters and our shores, often fighting to convey the sense of urgency and quick action that this crisis demands; and,

WHERAS, The American people continue to offer their support through prayers and charitable donations, and business owners and scientists share their ideas for stopping the oil; and,

WHERAS, Louisianians all across the world are united in hope for an end to this catastrophic event and pray for the recovery of our coastline, the rehabilitation of our fish and wildlife and the restoration of our extraordinary coastal areas that are unlike any other place in the world; and,

WHEREAS, Our collective fight to recover from this crisis and prevent future damage continues today;

NOW, THEREFORE,

I, Bobby Jindal, Governor of the State of Louisiana, do hereby proclaim June 27, 2010 as a Statewide Day of Prayer In the State of Louisiana and in the Gulf of Mexico.
