If one was presented with a unique opportunity to be the voice of a prophet\* and speak before a king like Ezekiel, Jeremiah, Moses, Isaiah... - what would one say? What would one say if they could speak to President Obama even if just briefly?

I asked this question to a number of people and no one gave a biblical response. The varied responses were from not even attending to just being polite/civil.

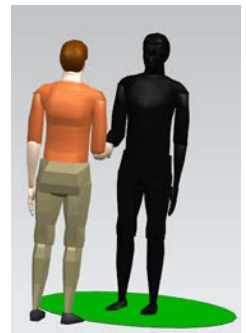
What's the biblical response? How should one witness to a world leader if you just had a momentary/flash hand shake?

This question was thrust on me as "the leader of the free world", President Obama, came within range of potential flash contact

Like it or not, President Obama is the acting king of the world. He commands the world's monetary system (dollar denominated) and pays off foreign nations thru foreign aid. He's the Commander in chief of the military which is able to attack any nation that are deemed a threat (Egypt, Libya, Syria, Afghanistan, Iraq...), drone strikes without consequences... without any other country stepping in and being able to prevent it. It's reminiscent of the king of Babylon military conquest of the world at that time however the US military is spread out farther than Nebuchadnezzar ever dreamed of with the US military in over 135+ countries around the world

If one could briefly shake Pres. Obama's hand and say something what would the appropriate blurb be?

My desire was to be up front to shake his hand and do what John the Baptist and Jesus proclaimed "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand" Mt3:1-2, 4:17 or just "Repent" if contact is just momentarily.



RSV Matthew 3:1-2

- 1 IN THOSE days came John the Baptist, preaching in the wilderness of Judea,
- 2 "**Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.**"

RSV Matthew 4:17 From that time Jesus began to preach, saying, "**Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.**"

This desire is not without risks. The stakes are high. Looking in the bible at the previous reproofing of kings of Israel and Judah by the prophets demonstrates that leaders or anyone engaging in sinful acts really don't appreciate others telling them what they are doing is wrong. They have no problem you commending them on the sinful act but don't judge them - judge not lest you be judge is what non leaders say but judge not lest I crush you is what leaders do as Dr. Ben Carson found out by dressing down President Obama's health care act during a February 2013 prayer breakfast while president Obama watched on. Dr. Carson received an IRS Audit for his comments.

There were 3 notable prophets that were killed in the New Testament: Jesus, John the Baptist and Steven.

- Jesus (Mt26:59) Chief Priest, Elders, Council sought false witness against Jesus to put him to death because Jesus threatened the religious ruling class power –Jn11:48.
- John the Baptist (Mt14:3-5) John told King Herod that he couldn't have his brother's wife embarrassing the ruler.
- Steven (Acts7:51-54) Steven accused the Jewish leaders of being the sons of the rulers who killed the prophets, who also don't keep the law and resist the Holy Ghost. Steven said that the Jewish rulers were as fake as the megalithic TV evangelist these days.

There were 2 prophets that the Kings of the Old Testament listened to and obeyed: Nathan and Oded

**Listening to the prophets**

- Nathan (2Sam12:13) told King David of his sins and King David repented of his adultery with Bathsheba and murder of Uriah.
- Oded (2Chron28:9-15) to Northern kingdom after sacking Jerusalem and taking prisoners and booty. They listened to the prophet Oded and let go of the prisoners and booty.

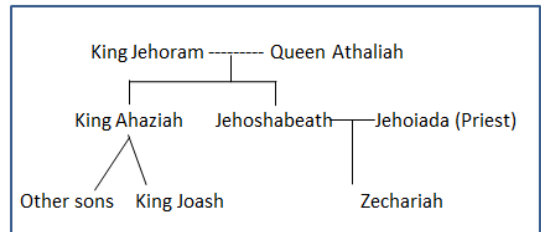
There were many prophets which the kings of the old testament killed off because they didn't accept the prophets message.

**Kings refusing the prophets**

- Jeremiah (Jer38:1-10) prophesied the fall of Jerusalem, was arrested, thrown into dungeon in mire clay and left to starve to death.
- Obadiah (1Kg18:3-4) Jezebel killed the prophets but Obadiah saved 100 prophets by hiding them 50 prophets in separate caves and fed them
- Elijah (1Kg19:1-4) Jezebel said that Elijah would be killed within 24 hours – Elijah fled. Elijah previously killed 450 prophets of Baal and 400 prophets of the grove [400 prophets of the grove only mentioned in the Septuagint] – 1Kg18:22,40.

The above show an abuse of power against God's prophets. These weren't the worst deception of a prophet. What prophet received the worst of the worst treatment as a prophet?

The worst treatment of a prophet was against Zechariah. This Zechariah was an Old Testament prophet (not John the Baptist father). His life and death are contained in 3 short verses but the story begins 3 chapters before.



Jehu gets anointed to kill all the house of Ahab (2Chron22:7). Jehu kills the reigning king, King Ahaziah. King Ahaziah's mother, Athaliah, kills off all her grandsons and reigns as a Queen for 6 years. Unbeknownst to Queen Athaliah, one of King Ahaziah's sons, Joash, survives because Jehoshabeath who was King Ahaziah sister hides him. Jehoshabeath is also wife of Jehoiada the priest.

Jehoiada the priest raises, teaches and trains Joash from a 1 year old until Joash was 7 years old. At 7 years old, Joash becomes King (2Chron24:1) and King Joash reigns for 40 years. Jehoiada the priest

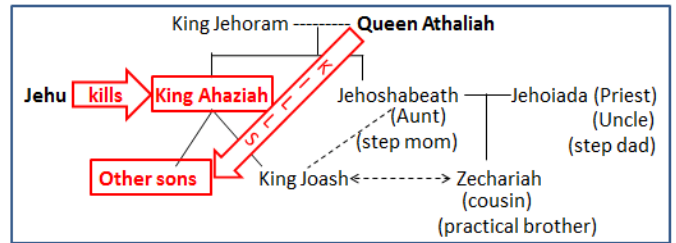
guided King Joash for 35 of the 40 years of his reign and King Joash did what was right in the sight of the Lord (2Chron24:2). Once Jehoiada the priest died at 130 years old then King Joash listened to the corrupt chiefs of Judah and forsook the Lord (2Chron24:17-18).

God then sends prophets to King Joash and they are ignored – 2Chron24:19.

God then sends Zechariah the priest to King Joash and states to the King “Why transgress ye the commandments of the Lord, that ye cannot prosper? because ye have forsaken the Lord, he hath also forsaken you.” – 2Chron24:20.

King Joash ordered Zechariah to be stoned to death – 2Chron24:21.

The reason why priest/prophet Zechariah death is so despicable was that Zechariah’s father was Jehoiada the priest. Zechariah’s mother was the woman who saved King Joash as an infant from being put to death. Zechariah was King Joash’s half -brother because Jehoiada the priest raised both and they were around the same age.



This deception was one brother killing another because he didn’t like what was said. King Joash didn’t honor his step-parents by honoring their son – 2Chron24:22.

Telling the President to repent has the real possibility of causing me to lose my job since all the President stops are in safe stops - no controversy, opposition or demonstration allowed.

When given an opportunity to do God’s will, one needs to take it and I decided to act on the opportunity.

Difference between belief and faith is that believer believes a fact with his heart (Acts8:37). A faither believes and acts – by works a man in justified and not by faith alone –Jm2:24. Faith involves putting what you believe into action.



Faith without works is dead (James 2:20). If one wishes to make contact with the President then one has to do something other than just believing that it’s possible for one to shake the president’s hand. One has to walk across the gap not just believing that one could walk across.

Some of the basic requirements to gain access to the President were already fulfilled.

- 1) Located in the same state/city as the President’s stop
- 2) Employee of the company that the President was going to speak to
- 3) Employer granting/wanting employees to attend

The first 3 are merely belief because it requires no action from oneself. The faith steps puts your belief into action. Some of the requirements to see the President were:

- 4) Sign up for Secret Security prescreening
- 5) Go to the event – humble yourself thru the screening process:
  - i) everything out of your pockets
  - ii) go thru the magnetic scanner
  - iii) go thru the magnetic wand
- 6) Preposition yourself at the front of the stage



Every world leader who has engaged in vile acts of abortion get demonic power from doing them or sowing the seeds of it (sower and protector of the the abortion policies and the reaper of the unborn from the womb are the same - Jn4:36-37 paraphrased) In 2Kg3:27 the King of Moab sacrificed his eldest son on the wall. This son was going to reign after him. This gave the Moab King power and he was able to defeat the Israelite.

When you go before a physical or spiritual power you have to prepare yourself.

- Joseph cleaning up before Pharaoh – Gen41:14 (shaved and changed clothes)
- Jesus said to come against certain demonic spirits you must first prepare yourself with prayers and fasting – Mt17:21

One concern that I had was I had no spiritual wingmen to help me at the event. All the spiritual wingmen would be from afar similar to the reconnaissance teams far into enemy territory beyond the help of mortars and howitzers. All support would be from the air. I remembered Daniel's prayer was halted for 21 days due because the prince of Persia stopped the angel from getting to Daniel –Dan10:12-13 and in Ecclesiastes 4:12 it's mentioned that standing alone will get you beat up, wear you out and may defeat you.

Preparations that were upon my heart was:

-- **Prayer and fasting.** Going up against the demonic power of the President involves more than just a simple prayer. Fasting is a requirement. Jesus fasted 40 days prior to his entanglement with the devil after Jesus' baptism. The bible says you humble your soul with fasting Ps35:13 & Ex19:14-15 (fasting – no food, water, spousal sexual contact)

-- **Proper mindset and purpose.** Jesus says that we are to warn the wicked otherwise their blood will be on our heads Ez3:18. When given the opportunity to warn the wicked then one should do the will of God – thy will be done –Mt6:10.

-- **Fire team prayer power.** The basic unit of a fire team is a two person unit – a man and his wife. Both must be united in mind, purpose and spirit for the action otherwise the spouse can tear down the prayers of the other (friendly fire) – 1Pt3:7

-- **Worldwide Prayer group reinforcements/ backup.** Having a group of people praying for your cause will boost the prayer force against an enemy with incredible power. I submitted a prayer request for help on this effort believing that it would, without doubting -Mt21:21

--**Anointing/unanointing oil.** One of the basic weapons that should be on every soldier's equipment belt is a bottle of anointing/unanointing oil. Knowing I'll have to go thru security, I put a good quantity of oil on my hair (Ex29:7) to brush my hair moments before the hand shaking of the president – further boosting up the prayer power by putting the unanointing oil on the President.

I went thru security three and a half hours prior to the 15 minute speech of President Obama.

When I entered into the main room, I saw the mass wall of people who had arrived an hour earlier.

I realized that I failed to take seriously the task Jesus commissioned me to perform.

Even the Harry Potter, Twilight and zombie fans are more faithful to their gods by camping out hours and hours before any new movie or book in order to get the best seats in the theater or the first to get their book signed.

I sinned and went an hour after the opening of the doors instead of being at the front of the line waiting.

The second sin was an overwhelming feeling of failure of not being able to get to the front just by walking up.



When I in the room I was seized what I can only describe as a spirit of infirmity. I knew what I wanted to do but mentally I was locked in place similar to Paul's position in Rm7:19 of doing what he didn't want to do instead of what he wanted to do.

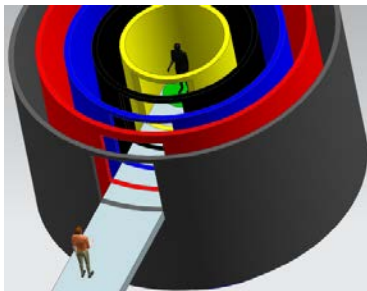
During the 3.5 hour wait I did notice someone across the room ebb closer and closer to the stage, one person at a time. I saw this but I didn't believe in my mind that it could be me instead of him.

Jesus can use the weak and the foolish but He doesn't use those who don't take action. Jesus can set the stage, roll out the red carpet, unlock all the doors but if you believe that you can't do it then the door will be closed. The President was less than 50 feet away but mentally he might as well be across the world due to my frozen position.

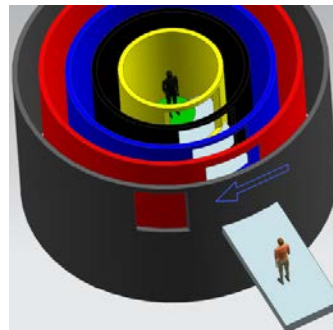
Elijah asked the people "How long will you hesitate between two opinions? If the LORD is God follow Him, but if Baal, follow him." But the people did not answer him a word – 1Kg18:21

That was my position. I knew nothing is impossible with God but I also thought I couldn't do it. Two opinions were in my mind causing me to be frozen in place.

Jesus's desire/will – all doors open.



My perspective – final door closed – my mental door.



President Obama claims he is a Christian but not thru deeds. President Obama said in his speech in Albuquerque in 2010 that he was "Christian by choice" and that the bedrock strength of this country is the embracement of multiple faiths and atheism and that we are to revere and respect those religions as much as true Christianity (see article attached).

Ps33:12 states "Blessed is the nation whose God is the Lord". Israel of old was cursed by Jesus (God of the Old and New Testament) for worshiping and tolerating other Gods within the borders of Israel. This country was founded on Christianity; this country was blessed by Jesus for solely worshiping Jesus and the Father not any other false gods. Jesus said in Mt12:30 that "he who is not with Me is against me".

All the other religions are those of the anti-Christ (1Jn2:22) since all other religions that President Obama mentioned (Jews, Muslims, Hindus, atheists, agnostics, Buddhists) all deny that Jesus is the Christ. A nation who is confused with who is the creator of all seen and unseen will also not be able to distinguish good from evil and that nation is in a tailspin downward.

That opportunity presented itself a few days later which gave me the opportunity to redeem myself – but that is a study for another time.

## Obama says he's Christian 'by choice'

At a campaign stop in Albuquerque, the president responds to a question about his faith by saying 'the precepts of Jesus Christ spoke to me in terms of the kind of life that I would want to lead.'

ALBUQUERQUE, N.M. — President Obama said Tuesday that he is a "Christian by choice" and that his decision was influenced by gospel teachings about salvation and the importance of loving one another.

His mother and the grandparents who helped raised him weren't regular churchgoers, Obama told a group of voters here. But he became a Christian "later in life" because of the religion's basic principles, he said.

"It was because the precepts of Jesus Christ spoke to me in terms of the kind of life that I would want to lead," Obama said. "Being my brother's and sister's keeper. Treating others as they would treat me."

Obama met with the voters group as part of a nationwide political swing as he tries to rally Democratic voters in advance of the Nov. 2 congressional elections. Later Tuesday, Obama traveled to Madison, Wis., to speak to a large gathering of students and others at the University of Wisconsin.

His remarks in Albuquerque came in response to a question from the crowd about his religious faith, allowing the president to veer away from economics, the subject matter dominating the meeting.

The issue of Obama's beliefs is a popular subject of debate on cable talk shows and the Internet. Recent polling data suggests that a growing number of Americans think Obama is a Muslim.

But Obama on Tuesday gave a personal accounting of his faith more intimate than any since he published a 1999 memoir of his life.

"Understanding that Jesus Christ dying for my sins spoke to the humility we all have to have as human beings, that we're sinful and we're flawed, we make mistakes," Obama said Tuesday. "And that we achieve salvation through the grace of God."

Although flawed, individuals can "still see God in other people" and help others to find "their own grace."

"So that's what I strive to do. That's what I pray to do every day," Obama said. "I think my public service is part of that effort to express my Christian faith."

Despite his personal beliefs, Obama said, he believes that the "bedrock strength" of the country is its embrace of many faiths, and also of no faith.

Although the country is predominantly Christian, "we have Jews, Muslims, Hindus, atheists, agnostics, Buddhists," he said. Their own "path to grace is one that we have to revere and respect as much as our own."

## **IRS targeted Dr. Ben Carson after Prayer Breakfast speech**

Just months after he gave a speech

earlier this year that challenged America's leadership in President Obama's presence, Dr. Ben Carson was targeted by IRS agents who requested to review his real estate holdings and then conducted a full audit without finding any wrongdoing.

"I guess it could be a coincidence, but I never had been audited before and never really had any encounters with the IRS," Dr. Carson said in an interview Thursday with The Washington Times. "But it certainly would make one suspicious because we know now the IRS has been used for political purposes and therefore actions like this come under suspicion."

Dr. Carson is a world-renown neurosurgeon whose rise from poverty and a single-parent home, and his medical work with pediatric patients was celebrated in a movie called "Gifted Hands." He has electrified the conservative world with speeches and columns since his February National Prayer Breakfast

speech in front of Mr. Obama, in which he decried the "moral decay and fiscal irresponsibility" of America in recent years. He writes a weekly column for The Times.

Dr. Carson first hinted at the problem earlier this week during a speech in Alabama when he made a vague reference to having his first "encounter with the IRS" earlier this year.

Dr. Carson told The Times that IRS agents contacted him in June — less than four months after the speech — and requested to review his real estate holdings. After finding nothing that concerned them, the agents then informed him they were conducting a full audit of his finances, and then asked to go back an additional year to review his records, he said.

They finally ended the review in August after finding no problems, Dr. Carson said.

"They told me everything was in good standing and left," he said.

Asked whether he thought the audit was a retaliation for his speech, Dr. Carson quipped: "I guess I'm surprised it took them that long."

He said the more serious issue is that the IRS has been politicized — "something that should never have happened" — and that leaves all of its activities open to suspicion.

A call seeking comment from the IRS Thursday morning went unanswered. The agency has furloughed more than 90 percent of its staffers during the government shutdown.

In his prayer breakfast speech, Dr. Carson called for a free market approach to improving the nation's health care system, knocking the bureaucracy and control measures of Obamacare.

"Here's my solution: When a person is born, give him a birth certificate, an electronic medical record, and a health savings account to which money can be contributed — pretax — from the time you're born 'til the time you die," Dr. Carson said. "If you die, you can pass it on to your family members, and there's nobody talking about death panels. We can make contributions for people who are indigent. Instead of sending all this money to some bureaucracy, let's put it in their HSAs. Now they have some control over their own health care. And very quickly they're going to learn how to be responsible."

The speech, which reverberated across the political landscape and had the The Wall Street Journal editorial page calling for Dr. Carson to run for president, also criticized liberal tax policies favored by Mr. Obama.

"What about our taxation system? It's so complex there is no one who can possibly comply with every jot and tittle of our tax system. What we need to do is come up with something that is simple," Carson stated. "You make \$10 billion, you put in a billion. You make \$10, you put in \$1 — of course, you gotta get rid of the loopholes, but now some people say, 'That's not fair because it doesn't hurt the guy who made \$10 billion as much as the guy who made \$10.' Where does it say you have to hurt the guy? He's just put in a billion in the pot! We don't need to hurt him.

"It's that kind of thinking that has resulted in 602 banks in the Cayman Islands. That money needs to be back here, building our infrastructure and creating jobs — and we're smart enough to figure out how to do that."

He also focused on the nation's moral decay and its similarities to ancient Rome.

"I think particularly about ancient Rome. Very powerful. Nobody could even challenge them militarily, but what happened to them? They destroyed themselves from within. Moral decay, fiscal irresponsibility. They destroyed themselves. If you don't think that can happen to America, you get out your books and you start reading, Dr. Carson said.

"Our deficit is a big problem. Think about it. Our national debt — \$16.5 trillion — you think that's not a lot of money? I'll tell you what, count one number per second ... You know how long it would take you to count to 16 trillion? 507,000 years — more than a half a million years to get there. We have to deal with this."

11 Now hear me, and send back the captives from your kinsfolk whom you have taken, for the fierce wrath of the Lord is upon you."  
12 Certain chiefs also of the men of Ephraim, Azariah the son of Johanan, Berechiah the son of Meshillemoth, Jehizkiah the son of Shallum, and Amasa the son of Hadlai, stood up against those who were coming from the war,

4 Then the princes said to the king, "Let this man be put to death, for he is weakening the hands of the soldiers who are left in this city, and the hands of all the people, by speaking such words to them. For this man is not seeking the welfare of this people, but their harm."  
5 King Zedekiah said, "Behold, he is in your hands; for the king can do nothing against you."  
6 So they took Jeremiah and cast him into the cistern of Malchiah, the king's son, which was in the court of the guard, letting Jeremiah down by ropes. And there was **no water in the cistern, but only mire, and Jeremiah sank in the mire.**  
7 When Ebed-melech the Ethiopian, a eunuch, who was in the king's house, heard that they had put Jeremiah into the cistern--the king was sitting in the Benjamin Gate--  
8 Ebed-melech went from the king's house and said to the king,  
9 "My lord the king, these men have done evil in all that they did to Jeremiah the prophet by casting him into the cistern; and he will **die there of hunger, for there is no bread left in the city.**"

3 And Ahab called Obadiah, who was over the household. (Now Obadiah revered the Lord greatly;  
4 and when **Jezebel cut off the prophets of the Lord,** Obadiah took a hundred prophets and hid them by fifties in a cave, and fed them with bread and water.)

RSV 1 Kings 19:1-4

1 AHAB TOLD Jezebel all that Elijah had done, and how he had slain all the prophets with the sword.  
2 Then Jezebel sent a messenger to Elijah, saying, "**So may the gods do to me, and more also, if I do not make your life as the life of one of them by this time tomorrow.**"  
3 Then he was afraid, and he arose and went for his life, and came to Beer-sheba, which belongs to Judah, and left his servant there.  
4 But he himself went a day's journey into the wilderness, and came and sat down under a broom tree; and he asked that he might die, saying, "It is enough; now, O Lord, take away my life; for I am no better than my fathers."
